The Service Project for May is Teens Against Drugs (TAD) Activity Center. They are requesting Cash donations for snacks for their summer program, or games (no puzzles)

Here are a few facts about the center:

- The Mission of TAD is to educate children, teenagers, and the community on drug awareness and the prevention of drug abuse.
- Anti-Drug Programs: The Cumberland Country Drug Alliance was formed in 1987 and founded the TAD Center as part of a state-wide anti-drug campaign. To carry out the mission the Alliance has established the following:
 - Just Say No Clubs all elementary schools in the county,
 - Junior TAD Clubs in 7th and 8th grades,
 - Teens Against Drugs at Cumberland County High School
- Several other classes or meeting opportunities are available at the center:
 - Early Intervention Classes, designed for youth to 18, who violate the Tennessee Drug Free Youth Act,
 - Abuse Intervention for Men are court-ordered meetings for men who have been in court for spousal abuse.
 - Safe Driving court-ordered classes for drivers convicted of various serious driving offenses.
- The TAD Center provides alternative activities for the youth of the community that are fun and drug-free.
- The center is available for activities by other groups that also help our youth find a drug-free lifestyle, such as churches, schools, Boy Scouts, and Girl Scouts.
